What do your placement scores mean?

Rio uses scores from the ACCUPLACER and WRITEPLACER to determine your eligibility for the CCP Program under the State Standards that have been set. Rio Advisors will also use your scores to place you in the appropriate classes for your skill level.

Accuplacer- Quantitative, Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics

You Qualify for the Math portion of the CCP Program.

You do not qualify for the Math portion of the CCP Program but can be deemed Conditionally Eligible for the CCP program due to a GPA of 3.0 or higher or a Letter Recommendation from your Guidance Counselor

You are not eligible for the Math portion of the CCP Program and cannot be deemed Conditionally Eligible due to Math scores.

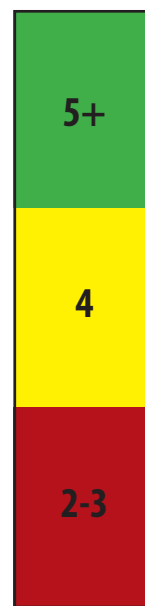

You Qualify for the English portion of the CCP Program.

You do not qualify for the English Portion of the CCP Program but you can be deemed Conditionally Eligible for the CCP Program due to a GPA of 3.0 or higher or a Letter of Recommendation from your Guidance Counselor.

You are not eligible for the English portion of the CCP Program and cannot be deemed Conditionally Eligible due to English scores.



ACT Sub Scores to be eligible for the CCP Program: English-18 Reading-22 Math-22 ACT Sub Scores to be "Conditionally Eligible" for the CCP Program: English- 16-17 Reading- 20-21 Math- 20-21.

What does Conditionally Eligible mean?

If you score in the "Conditionally Eligible" range, in one or both of the testing categories, you can still be deemed eligible to participate in the CCP Program due to a GPA of 3.0 or a Letter of Recommendation from your Guidance Counselor. You would still need to take an English or Math class at your home High School but, you would still be able to take classes in the non-English and non-Math categories, that do not require a prerequisite in the English or Math categories. Your Rio Counselor will help you schedule the appropriate classes for you.

PLACEMENT EXAM

Check with your Guidance office to see if your high school will be hosting an in-house Placement Exam for the students at your school. If not, please contact Ciara Small at csmall@rio.edu or call 740-245-7210 to find the best place to take your placement exam.



APPLICATION

After you have taken your Placement Exam and have been deemed eligible for the CCP Program, you will need to complete a College Credit Plus application and have it signed by your guidance counselor. HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

You will need to submit your High School Transcript with your completed application before the application deadline. If you place in the Conditionally Eligible range, your transcript will be used to verify if you meet the 3.0 GPA.

After the CCP Coordinator receives all forms and information listed above, you will be contacted through mail or email to let you know when to contact your Rio Advisor to Schedule an Advising appointment.

- **Spring Application Deadline – December 1, 2020**
- **Summer Application Deadline – May 1, 2021**
- **Fall Application Deadline – August 1, 2021**
